4 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE


Signals made ashore will be displayed at the flagpole on the main lawn of the club.

7 RACING AREAS

Attachment 1 of the NoR shows the location of the racing areas.

8 THE COURSES

8.4 For course LA, the starting line and finishing line will follow the diagram to the right. This changes the course diagrams for course LA in RRS S and in Attachment 2 of the NoR. Both the starting and finishing marks may be in place during a start or a finish.



9 MARKS

- **9.1** Marks 1, 2p and 2s will be orange tetrahedrons.
- 9.2 The offset mark 1a will be an orange ball.

- **9.3** New marks as provided in instruction 12.1 will be yellow tetrahedrons.
- **9.4** The starting marks will be the race committee signal boat at the starboard end and an orange ball at the port end.
- **9.5** The finishing marks will be the race committee signal boat at the starboard end and a small yellow tetrahedron at the port end.

11 THE START

11.1 The starting line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the starboard end signal boat and the course side of the port-end starting mark.

13 THE FINISH

13.1 The finishing line will be between a staff displaying a blue flag on the starboard end signal boat and the course side of the port-end finishing mark.
