1 RULES

1.4 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

2 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located on the upper waterfront deck (La Marinière).

4 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

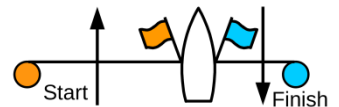
Signals made ashore will be displayed at the flagpole on the main lawn of the club.

7 RACING AREAS

Attachment 1 of the NoR shows the location of the racing areas.

8 THE COURSES

8.4 For course LA, the starting line and finishing line will follow the diagram to the right. This changes the course diagrams for course LA in RRS S and in Attachment 2 of the NoR. Both the starting and finishing marks may be in place during a start or a finish.



9 MARKS

9.1 Marks 1, 2p and 2s will be orange tetrahedrons.

9.2 The offset mark 1a will be an orange ball.

9.3 New marks as provided in instruction 12.1 will be yellow tetrahedrons.

9.4 The starting marks will be the race committee signal boat at the starboard end and an orange ball at the port end.

9.5 The finishing marks will be the race committee signal boat at the starboard end and a small yellow tetrahedron at the port end.

11 THE START

11.1 The starting line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the starboard end signal boat and the course side of the port-end starting mark.

13 THE FINISH

13.1 The finishing line will be between a staff displaying a blue flag on the starboard end signal boat and the course side of the port-end finishing mark.

15 PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

15.1 The race office is located at the clubhouse of Beaconsfield Yacht Club.
