JUNIOR SAILING PROGRAMS – SUMMER 2026

Wet Feet , CANSail I, II, III, IV and V courses. Learning to sail will provide a life time of enjoyment anywhere your child's life takes them. Independence, confidence & team work. There is nothing quite like it.

THE PROGRAM:

The Junior Squadron sailing program is designed to teach the safe and proper handling of a small sailboat. Juniors are taught the theory and techniques as outlined by Sail Canada (C.Y.A.) with as much practice time on the water as possible, weather permitting. While on the water, the juniors will be supervised by our Sail Canada approved instructors, from power rescue boats. The students will be taught and tested on the CANSail "learn to sail" standards starting with Cansail 1 through to Cansail VI. Once the fundamentals have been mastered, the more advanced students will be introduced to small boat racing.

Please note: All our sailing programs run from 9 am to 4 pm, Monday to Friday. The camp is open during statutory holidays. Race Teams run on individual schedules issued by the coaches.

Two Week Session Programs:

Wet Feet program: Novices age 7 to 10

Cost: \$679 / two-week session

The Wet Feet program will introduce youngsters to the joys of "messaging around in boats".

Opti CANSail 1& 2 program: Novices age 9 to 13 (max 125 lbs)

Cost: \$701 / two-week session

BYC is now able to offer CanSail1+2 programs in Opti's as well as the possibility of an introduction to racing element if experience allows. This program is open to youth age 9-13 years of age who have completed a WETFEET program. One student per boat. Due to Optimist Class Rules a maximum weight limit of 125lbs. is imposed for this program.

JUNIOR SAILING PROGRAMS – SUMMER 2026

Beginners, Ages 10 to 17 yrs

Basic Sailing Skills CANSail 1+2

Cost: \$701 / two-week session

This course is Monday to Friday, for the duration of 2 weeks. Students will sail our club Flying Jr's. Students will learn the basic skills of sailing from rigging to your position in the boat, steering sail handling etc.

Session 2 - Monday, July 6 to Friday, July 17

Four Week Session Programs:

Beginners, Ages 10 to 17 yrs

Basic Sailing Skills CANSail 1+2

Cost: \$1,167 / four-week session

Session 1 – Wednesday, June 24 to Friday July 17 (\$1050.30)

Session 2 - Monday, July 20 to Friday, August 14

Advanced Sailing Skills CANSail 3+4 ages 10 – 17yrs

Cost: \$1,167 / four-week session

This course is Monday to Friday, 4 week session. Students will sail our club 420's. Student's will take their "basic" skills to another level developing further their skipper and crewing skills. Spinnaker and trapeze will be introduced.

Session 1 – Monday, June 22 to Friday July 17

Session 2 - Monday, July 20 to Friday, August 14

Cancellation & Refund Policy: Any cancellation requests received after May 25th will be subject to a **\$200 administration fee**. Please note that once the school has officially commenced on June 24th, no cancellations will be accepted, and no refunds or credits will be issued.

CLOTHING AND SAFETY GEAR: Students must wear soft-soled shoes and bring their own **MINISTRY OF TRANSPORT** approved Personal Flotation Device (PFD). Water ski vests, belts, and air cell jackets are **NOT** acceptable. The student will not be permitted on the water if the safety equipment does not meet the approval of the Club Manager.

LANGUAGE OF INSTRUCTION: Courses are conducted primarily in English; however, our instructors are bilingual and will assist any student in either of Canada's official languages.


